

ARTICULATION AGREEMENT

The purpose of the Articulation Agreement is to assist students holding an Associate of Arts degree to transfer smoothly from a partner institution to Williams Baptist University. Through collaborative efforts, the partners hope to increase graduation rates, facilitate the transfer process, and foster greater collegiality in the intellectual marketplace of Arkansas.

Satisfactory completion of an Associate of Arts degree designed for transfer will be accepted as satisfying the general education requirements of Williams Baptist University. (Note: All students, including transfer students, earning a baccalaureate degree at Williams must complete 6 hours of bible.) This agreement does not address specific degree requirements outside of the General Education component, such as major or minor courses. Students should select those courses based on the specific degree requirements of Williams Baptist University. A student who holds an Associate of Arts degree with a 2.0 cumulative grade point average will be accepted for transfer subject to conditions outlined in the respective Articulation Agreement.
